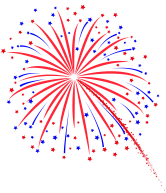

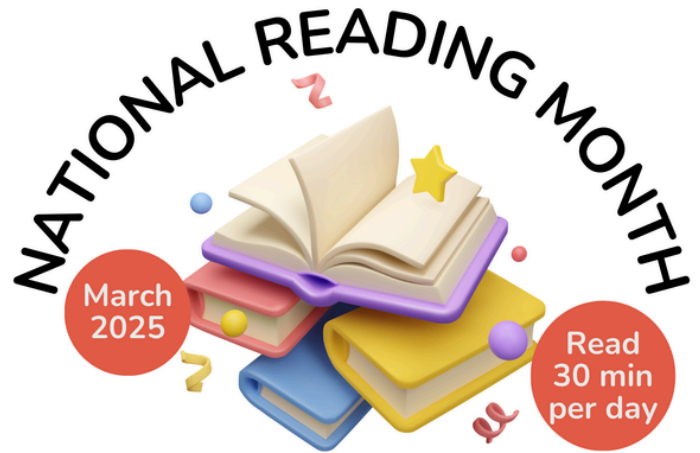

Features include childrens, teen and adult library areas, wide selection of movies, computers, STEM kits, and great wifi! There's always something going on at this hub of our community - Senior exercise classes and luncheons and games, book clubs, Tot Time, card and game clubs, yoga classes and more.
